 Step 1 - Knowledge & Comprehension


Find an example of a comic book cover that you like. It can be from any existing character that you like. Examine the cover: What does it look like? What kind of imagery is used? Is there a title? Is there any other text? What kind of fonts are used? What colours are used? Do they help to give a mood to the cover?

 Step 2 - Application

Draw and colour a copy of the cover that you have chosen. Try to make it as accurate as possible.

 Step 3 - Analysis

What is the purpose of a cover? Who is the cover aimed at? What techniques did you use to reproduce the cover accurately? Did you ensure that the text was of a consistent size? How did you do this?

 Step 4 - Synthesis

Design your own cover for a comic book character of your choosing. You could make up your own character if you like. Consider the use of text, fonts, line and colour that you studied in your research.

 Extension Task - Evaluation

Explain what you did for this homework project. Talk about your research into your chosen comic book cover, the techniques and skills that you used and how well you think you did overall.
